Dear Parents/Guardians and Students,

ACS will be offering summer credit recovery from June 14 to June 29. The hours of operation for students are Monday - Thursday, 9:00am to 3:00pm for high school students. Credit Recovery will include instruction in high school courses required for graduation. You are receiving this notification because you did not successfully complete one or more core courses this year.

Credit Recovery will be offered using Edgenuity, an online credit recovery program. Once the student has successfully completed the Edgenuity course work for the course missed, they can move on to another course previously failed, if necessary. If no other course is required for credit recovery, attendance will no longer be required. Students will have the opportunity to recover up to 4 courses through Edgenuity. Students who only need to recover one course may opt to attend for either the morning or afternoon session. For grades, the student will receive a Pass or Fail mark on their transcript to show that they have earned the course credit for graduation, but it will not influence the student's GPA.

Participation in the summer credit recovery is optional, however, students who do not attend will have to earn the required credit by either retaking the entire course or completing credit recovery during or after school during subsequent school years. Students who would like to fully retake a course for grade replacement in future semesters may do so in lieu of credit recovery.

Important Information:

Attendance – Attendance is essential for course completion. Roll will be taken twice each day, at the beginning of class and again following the lunch break. There are no excused absences in summer school. Students with chronic absences or tardiness may be removed from the summer school program. Be sure to check your calendar and arrange vacation plans accordingly. Students may not remain on campus after class unless they are participating in a supervised high school activity.

Lunch - Students will need to sign up for school provided lunch or will have to bring a lunch for the day. Food delivery (by companies, parents, family, or friends) is not allowed.

School Safety - Students are expected to follow all rules as outlined by the ACS Code of Conduct. Students may not leave campus or go to any vehicles during break(s). Violation may result in the dismissal from the summer program.
