- Treasurer Report
 - \$3500 received in corporate sponsorships
 - \$180 correction to go to Direct Appeal to pay for pizza
 - Go Local Card Sales going on now
 - Go online to purchase and designate school for proceeds
 - Some stores are selling them (proceeds would be split between all schools)
 - Discussion to purchase cards for HFE staff, APPROVED to put in individual envelopes for staff to pick up in school office
 - Promotion through newsletter and school phone calls with Ms Buchanan
 - Restricted Funds explanation
 - Blacktop \$2250
 - 5th grade trip \$1550
 - Front playground \$605
 - Science Fair supplies \$250
- Elf Hat program update from Ms. Jives
 - All needs will be met through large monetary donations
 - Wrapping items will also be provided to families
 - Some items have been delivered to school
- Montessori Program relocated to HFE
 - HFE school community culture concerns
 - Due to lower enrollment and building size, there is space for APS at HFE
 - Should help our school grow due to maturation of students in program
 - No new enrollment, except for siblings into the program
 - Lots of discussion of building common language for creating a larger school community, school pride, family team
- \$100 gift cards for each classroom
 - Continue to wait until students are in the building
- Robotics team t-shirt funding request
 - Approved
- Support for teachers teaching at home
 - Might be more beneficial to support teachers with their first week back in the building in January
 - PTO to help with food to celebrate staff
 - All teaching staff should have all the materials and items for connectivity for teaching
 - In attempts to get children caught up on work and assignments, there might be less new assignments
 - In January, there will be more synchronous time for upper grades on Tuesday and Thursday
